GENERAL GRADUATION INFORMATION

This document contains information pertaining to graduation. Please retain this document, refer to it as needed and follow the timelines as stipulated.

DR. MARTIN LEBOLDUS CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION POLICY

1. In order to qualify to take part in all Graduation activities, students will have completed all requirements or be in a position to complete a Saskatchewan Grade 12 standing by June 30, 2026.
2. Students must acquire a minimum total of twenty-four (24) credits overall at the Secondary Level. Among your 24 credits, you must have:
 - Two of ELA A10, ELA B10 or Français 10
 - ELA 20 (and Français 20 for French Immersion)
 - Two of ELA A30, ELA B30 or Français 30
 - Science 10/Sciences 10
 - Science 20
 - History 10, Native Studies 10 or Histoire 10
 - One Social Science elective
 - Canadian Studies 30 (one of Social Studies 30, Native Studies 30 or Sciences Sociales 30)
 - Math 10 and 20 (one of Math 20 WA, Math Foundations 20 or Pre-Calculus 20)
 - Catholic Studies/Études Catholiques 10, 20, and 30
 - One of Wellness 10, Physical Education 20 or 30
 - French Immersion students need 12 credits in French (Français 10, 20, 30 MUST be included among them)
 - Five of the 24 credits must be at the 30-level

Note: To be eligible for graduation, students must:

- be passing all required classes by May 29th, 2026 **AND**
 - complete their 24 required credits by June 30th, 2026
2. The first potential graduation eligibility list has been posted outside of Student Services. It is the responsibility of each student to ensure that their name is on the list, and to verify the spelling and complete name, as this is exactly how the name will appear on the diploma. Students should notify Mrs. Hanson in Student Services of any changes.
 4. In keeping with school division policy, we at Dr. Martin LeBoldus Catholic High School believe that on graduation day a student's academic achievement should be recognized in a Catholic atmosphere. As a result, this celebration will be manifested at the graduation mass and the graduation exercises.

VALEDICTORIAN & SALUTATORIAN

The role of the VALEDICTORIAN is to serve as the representative voice of the entire graduating class. This position should be looked upon as an honour. The SALUTATORIAN, also an honoured position, has the responsibility of welcoming everyone to the graduation. This student also acts as a representative on behalf of the total group.

The valedictorian is a student with good academic standing who has contributed to the life of the school in many ways.

Eligible Candidates - Any student who is eligible for graduation and who is among the students with the 10 highest Honour Roll averages.

This average will be calculated approximately halfway through Semester 2 of the graduation year.

Only graduating students are eligible to participate in the voting procedures for these positions. The student receiving the most votes will be the Valedictorian, whereas the student who receives the second highest number of votes will be the Salutatorian. The development of speeches will be supported by Mrs. Hanson.

GRADUATION FEE

Each student participating in the graduation exercises will be required to pay a non-refundable fee of **\$100**. This fee covers expenses incurred in the following areas: keeper Cap, keeper Gown, keeper Stole, keeper pendant, keeper Grad Lawn Sign, Facility/Stage Rental, Technology, Art Legacy, Printing (Programs, Diplomas, Awards, Banners), Liturgy, Scholarship, and other expenses.

Fees for graduation will be collected on or before March 31, 2026. **Cash or SchoolCash online.** If paying cash, please place the cash in an envelope **with the student's name** on the front and drop it off at the main office. Please make sure that any outstanding school fees are paid as well. Any student with outstanding school fees must have all accounts good standing in order to participate in Graduation.

Art Legacy

The Grad Committee will select an appropriate piece of art created by one of our AP Art students. The artist will be paid and the piece will be suitably framed and displayed in the school as a donation to the school's art collection. The art works are displayed throughout the school with accompanying plaques.

Liturgy

The costs in this category include stipends for the celebrant and homilist at the graduation mass, the cost for the use of the facility as well as material used for the celebration (candles, flowers, audio equipment rental, print, etc.).

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ACADEMIC DRESS REQUIREMENTS

The academic dress worn by the graduand consists of a maroon gown and a cap (mortarboard) and a stole with the school logo. The cost of this is included in the graduation fee and all graduates will keep all caps, gowns & stoles.
