

Guidance Counselors

LEBOLDUS HAS TWO GUIDANCE COUNSELORS AVAILABLE TO ASSIST STUDENTS WITH PERSONAL ISSUES, COURSE SELECTIONS, CAREER CHOICES, POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS, AS WELL AS INFORMATION ABOUT ADDITIONAL COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES.

LEARNING RESOURCE TEACHER (LR)

THE LEARNING RESOURCE TEACHER ASSISTS STUDENTS WHO REQUIRE ACADEMIC SUPPORT AND REMEDIATION. DAILY, SCHEDULED TUTORIALS PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO FOCUS ON ACADEMICS, ORGANIZATIONAL SKILLS, AND STUDY SKILLS. LR TEACHERS ACT AS A LIAISON BETWEEN STUDENTS, TEACHERS, AND PARENTS. IN ADDITION, THEY COORDINATE AND COMMUNICATE ACADEMIC ADAPTATIONS (ROAS) THAT STUDENTS MAY REQUIRE TO BE SUCCESSFUL.

SCHOOL SUPPORT SPECIALIST (SSS)

THE SCHOOL SUPPORT SPECIALIST IS A LIAISON BETWEEN THE SCHOOL, STUDENTS' HOMES, AND THE COMMUNITY TO PROMOTE OPTIMAL SOCIAL - EMOTIONAL WELLNESS AND SUCCESS FOR STUDENTS. SPECIAL FOCUS IS GIVEN TO PROMOTE SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION FROM GRADE 8 TO GRADE 9.

Family Support Coordinator (FSC)

THE FAMILY SUPPORT COORDINATOR FOCUSES ON STUDENTS WHO REQUIRE INTENSIVE SUPPORT AND ARE NOT CONNECTED TO OUTSIDE AGENCIES FOR INDIVIDUAL SERVICE. THE FSC SUPPORTS STUDENTS STRUGGLING WITH MENTAL HEALTH, FAMILY DYNAMICS, HEALTH AND WELL-BEING, TRAUMA, BEHAVIOR (SUCH AS ANGER MANAGEMENT) AND STRESSORS. THE FSC WILL WORK WITH STUDENTS AND FAMILIES FOR 12-18 MONTHS; AFTER WHICH THEY WILL BE REASSESSED AND POSSIBLY REFERRED TO OUTSIDE AGENCIES. STUDENTS ARE REFERRED THROUGH THE VICE-PRINCIPAL OR STUDENT SERVICES.

Indigenous High School Advisor

THE INDIGENOUS HIGH SCHOOL ADVISOR BUILDS RELATIONSHIPS WITH INDIGENOUS STUDENTS AND FAMILIES AND SUPPORTS TRANSITIONS FROM ELEMENTARY TO HIGH SCHOOL TO POST-SECONDARY/CAREERS. THE ADVISOR FACILITATES CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES THAT ARE DESIGNED TO CREATE BELONGING FOR INDIGENOUS STUDENTS, UNDERSTANDING FOR NON-INDIGENOUS STUDENTS, AND TO SUPPORT TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION CALLS TO ACTION.



STUDENT SUPPORT TEAM (SST)

THIS SCHOOL-BASED TEAM CONSISTS OF OUR ADMINISTRATION, GUIDANCE COUNSELLORS, SCHOOL SUPPORT SPECIALIST, INDIGENOUS ADVISOR AND LEARNING RESOURCE TEACHER. THEY MEET ON A WEEKLY BASIS TO ADDRESS CONCERNS REGARDING STUDENTS' NEEDS - BEHAVIOURAL, ACADEMIC, SOCIAL, AND EMOTIONAL. STUDENTS ARE CLOSELY MONITORED FOR THEIR ATTENDANCE, ACADEMICS, AND BEHAVIOR.

ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE PROGRAM (EAL)

THIS PROGRAM SUPPORTS STUDENTS FROM NON-ENGLISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES IN DEVELOPING THEIR READING, WRITING, AND SPEAKING SKILLS. STUDENTS REQUIRING EAL SUPPORT MAY BE SCHEDULED IN A NON-CREDIT EAL GR. 9 CLASS OR ANY OF THE CREDITED EAL CLASSES AT THE GRADE 10 OR 11 LEVEL.

SETTLEMENT WORKER IN SCHOOL (SWIS)

A SWIS WORKER CAN HELP NEWCOMER CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES HAVE A MEANINGFUL SCHOOL EXPERIENCE. SETTLEMENT WORKERS IN SCHOOLS PROVIDED SERVICES IN ALL REGINA ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE PUBLIC, CATHOLIC AND FRENCH SCHOOL DIVISIONS.

STUDY HALL

A WEEKLY ACADEMIC SUPPORT OPPORTUNITY RAN BY TEACHERS VOLUNTEERING TIME AFTER SCHOOL. STUDENTS WORK IN THE LIBRARY UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THESE TEACHERS.

PEER TUTORING

THE GOAL OF THE PEER TUTORING PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH ASSISTANCE TO IMPROVE THEIR UNDERSTANDING IN SPECIFIC ACADEMIC SUBJECTS. STUDENTS, PARENTS, OR TEACHERS CAN REQUEST PEER TUTORING FOR A STUDENT. STUDENTS AND TUTORS MEET AT MUTUALLY CONVENIENT TIMES.


