- **Please note that PreCalc 30 is only available in English.**
- **Grade 12 Math Advanced Placement (AP):** Students will select Calculus 30AP AND Integral Calculus 30. **Classes are provided in English only.**

D. Science

- Students must have **at least one 20-level** Science to fulfill Ministry of Education requirements. Students can register for additional Science 20 or 30-level courses.
- Courses are available in **English only**.

- **Biology 30:** requires ONE OF Health Science 20 or Environmental Science 20
- **Earth Science 30:** requires ONE OF Environmental Science 20 or Physical Science 20
- **Physics 30:** requires Physical Science 20
- **Chem 30:** requires Physical Science 20
- **Computer Science 30:** requires Computer Science 20
