Instructions:

- All Grade 11 students must select a minimum of 8 classes (maximum 10 classes) (HP Phys. Ed., Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, and Instrumental Jazz Band, may be taken in addition to the 8 required classes.)

A. Catholic Studies

B. Languages

English Program:

- Students will choose either English Language Arts 20 **OR** English Language Arts 20AD (Advanced)
- Students in the Advanced pathway are advised to also choose Creative Writing 20 <u>OR</u> Media Studies 20 from the electives list

French Immersion Program:

- Students will choose Français 20 + English Language Arts 20 OR English Language Arts 20AD (Advanced)
- Students in the Advanced pathway are advised to also choose Creative Writing 20 OR Media Studies 20 from the electives list

C. Math

English and French Immersion students are required to select **A MINIMUM OF ONE** Math 20 class from the list of options if you have not already taken one (i.e. in Semester 2 of Grade 10). Additional math classes may be selected.

D. Science

- Students must have <u>at least one 20 level</u> Science to fulfill Ministry of Education requirements. Students can register for additional Science 20 courses.
- Courses are available in **English only**.
- Think about which Science 30 classes you plan on taking in the future to determine which 20 level Science classes you will select. (Please see the description of prerequisites in step 2 below.)

Step 1: Students will choose from one or more of the 4 prerequisite 20-level courses below prior to choosing a 30-level course.

- Health Science 20
- Environmental Science 20
- Physical Science 20
- Computer Science 20

Step 2: Students may choose additional Science classes based on the following prerequisite requirements:

Prerequisites for 30-level Science Classes:

- **Biology 30:** requires <u>ONE OF</u> Health Science 20 or Environmental Science 20
- **Earth Science 30:** requires <u>ONE OF</u> Environmental Science 20 or Physical Science 20
- Physics 30: requires Physical Science 20
- Chem 30: requires Physical Science 20
- Computer Science 30: requires Computer Science 20

E. Electives

All Grade 11 students must select a minimum of 8 classes (= HP Phys. Ed., Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, and Instrumental Jazz Band, may be taken in addition to the 8 required classes.)

NOTES:

- ✓ If you selected more than one Math or Science class, these would count as additional electives.
- ✓ Although a 20/30 level Social Science is not required for graduation, some post-secondary institutes do require that applicants have one of these completed in their grade 11 year.
- ✓ Therefore, if you plan on going on to post-secondary, we suggest taking one of these as an elective: History 20, Law 30, Psychology 20, Psychology 30, or AP Psychology 20/30.
- ✓ Physical Education 20 High Performance runs twice a week for the full year (1 credit).



Student Entering Course Requests On MSS Student Portal


The link to NYR course selection is https://mss.rcsd.ca/

All student's will have a user account in MSS that will allow them to select courses for next year. Students login credentials are the same as their regular computer username and password.

My Info Top Tab > Requests Side Tab




From here you can see the available courses you can select from. All of the Subject areas are listed, and when you click on the Select button beside the subject area, that will open a new window that will show you all the subject area courses. Some of the subject areas will have more than one page of courses available. You can scroll to the next page of courses using the drop down, or the next page arrow.



You can select multiple courses on a page, so select all the courses you need in the subject area, and then click the OK button at the bottom.

Once you have selected courses in a subject area, they will then show up on the main page, listing all the courses you have selected. It will also update the number or Requests and Credits on the top of the screen for you.



Posting

Once you have completed your course selections you will need to post the requests.

Click on the Post button at the bottom of the window. All selections will automatically save however, posting will timestamp your submission.
