D. Math

English and French Immersion students are required to select A MINIMUM OF ONE Math 10 course from the list of options. One additional math course may be selected. (The additional choice would then fill the spot of an elective.)

Note for French Immersion students: Due to the sequencing/scheduling of French Math courses, it is strongly advised that students choose BOTH **Math Fd et Prec 10** AND **Math Fd des Math 20** in their Grade 10 year.

Grade 10 Math Advanced Placement (AP) Pathway: Students will select Math Foundations Pre-Calculus 10 and Math Foundations 20. (Courses are available in English or French)






Once you have selected courses in a subject area, they will then show up on the main page, listing all the courses you have selected. It will also update the number of Requests and Credits on the top of the screen for you.
